Online learning

Please continue to use Seesaw, Accelerated Reader and Timetables Rockstars at home. These online learning apps really help your child to flourish. They can access the class homework activities, continue a wide range of reading and practise key skills needed to make progress. If you received new devices over the Christmas holiday please request a new password from the school office.

School Opening

You would have seen on the news that there is national issue with staffing at the minute. We will do everything in our power to keep the school open safely. However, there may be times that we do need to close if staffing levels drop critically and classes may return to remote learning at home. I cannot predict whether this would affect a single class, a Year group, or the whole school, but I can assure you it will be done in the best interests of our school community. SeeSaw enables our pupils to keep learning at home, and we will continue to use this. Please make sure your child can get access at home, or request passwords from the school office.

The main control is sticking to guidance, that if a family member tests positive, all family members should lateral flow test each day. This reduces transmission in the school. There are LFD in stock at local pharmacies and via 119 and NHS website.

New LA guidance received on 6th January

The Health Protection hub now require:

- The response to a single case in a class/group is to request 7 day LFD testing for the other children in the class/group.
- We are once again to alert you if your child is a close contact.



- **We require proof of negative lateral Flow test on day 6 and 7 if you intend to end isolation after a positive test. We continue to require proof of a negative PCR if applicable.**
